Make sure you arrive at least one hour before the first stage opens at 9.00am.

**By entering the venue you are accepting that you will follow the safety directions as given
to you by marshals and officials and only go to assigned areas.**

**REMEMBER being in an unsafe position or not following the marshals' instructions WILL
result in the stage being cancelled and you will see nothing ruining your day and that of
others who will be very unhappy!**

Respect the signs and tape – Prohibited Area MEANS prohibited area

Rally cars move quickly and may:

- **Run wide on corners**
- **Cut across corners**
- **Leave the road**
- **Throw up stones**
- **Do what you least expect**



Enjoy rallying... but TAKE CARE!

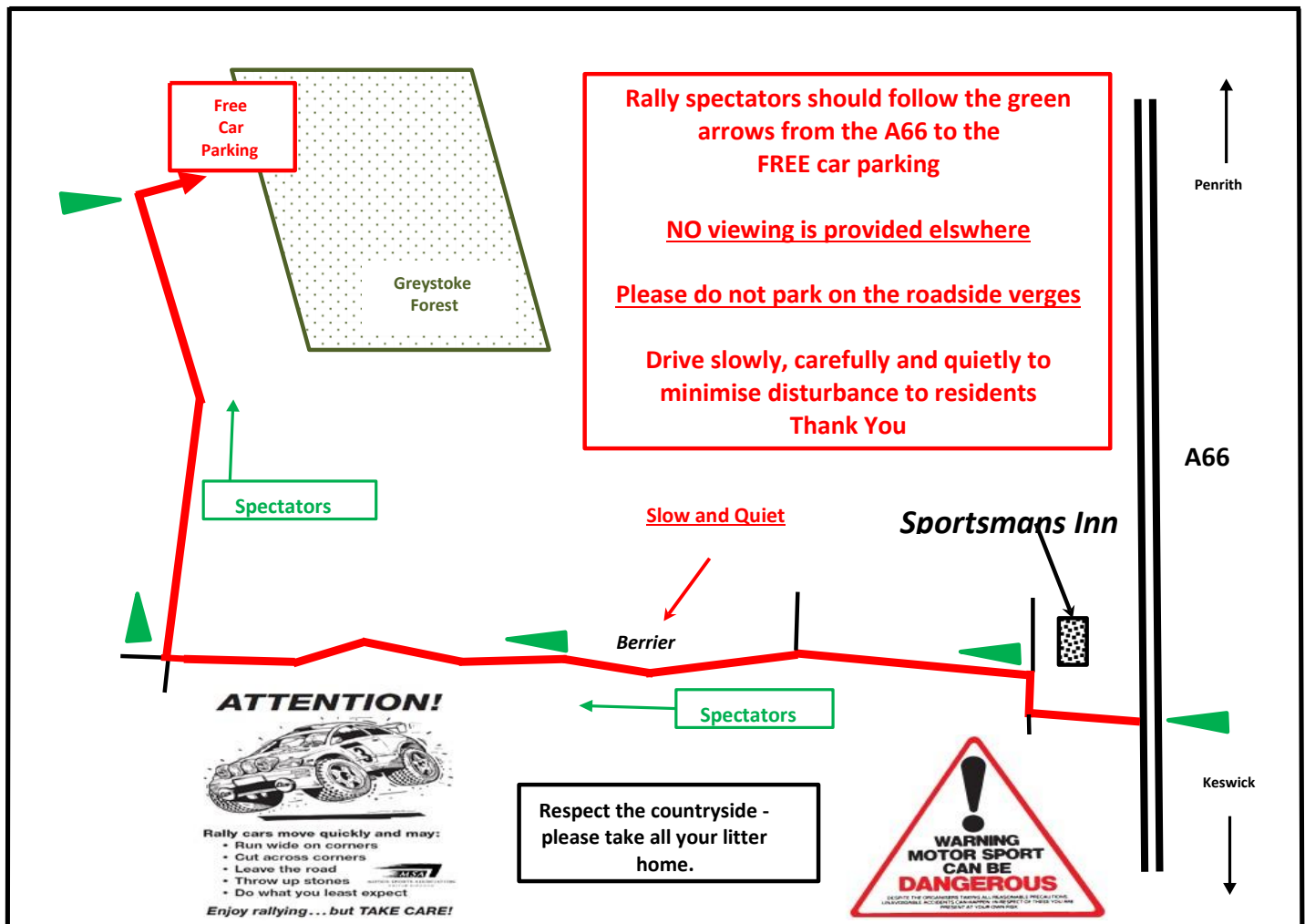
When spectating:

- **Always stand above the track, never below it**
- **Be aware of flying stones and slippery or rough surfaces**
- **Children should ALWAYS be accompanied by a responsible adult**
- **Please do not bring dogs to the event as they may be startled by loud noises**
- **Listen to the marshals – they are there to help everyone have a safe day**
- **Marshals and officials have the right to work without being abused or threatened. Abusive or threatening behaviour towards officials (who are all volunteers) will not be tolerated and spectators will be evicted from the event**
- **Please follow the Countryside Code and take all your litter home**
- **Consider your safety and that of others at all times.**

Spectator Parking Guide



Previous visitors to rallies at Greystoke will understand that problems are caused by parking vehicles on the verges around the forest. This not only gives difficulties for passing traffic and emergency vehicles but also damages verges that contain sensitive plants.

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE if you see anyone ignoring the No Parking signs have a polite word with them and suggest that they use the FREE car parking.

Parking on verges will put at risk the future running of all events.

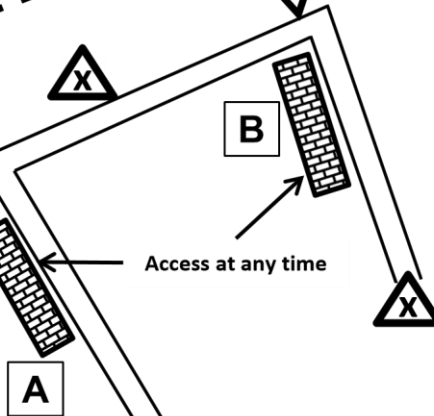

Spectator pedestrian access



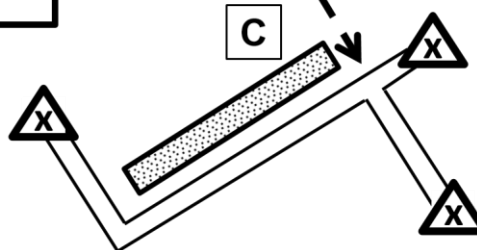
Access at any time

Note

Area C provides good viewing but it is very rough and may be wet.



The safety and sensible behaviour of spectators is vital to the future of rallying, so please be responsible for everyone's safety to ensure we can all continue to enjoy rallying.

We have provided spectator Area A with access available at any time. Area B access is via a marshal controlled crossing whilst at Area C you must stay in place until the stages are closed.

Note - There is NO spectator viewing from the Johnby access.

The viewing areas have slippery, uneven surfaces, wear suitable footwear and take care, they are not suitable for young children and pushchairs. The approximate times stages will run are 0900 to 1130 and 1230 to 1630 Safety Cars will inspect the stages before the first competitor.

Make sure you have reached your safe viewing position at least an hour before a stage runs.
